



THE COLLEGE CLUB OF CANTON SCHOLARSHIP GRANT INFORMATION

The College Club of Canton is a nonprofit organization operated to promote advanced education. The objectives are to sponsor programs for the improvement of learning in the greater Canton area and to encourage members, students, and the community to continue advanced education by providing pertinent programs and financial assistance. College Club is open to any woman with a baccalaureate degree, an associate degree or an RN license. Members can choose the amount of involvement they desire. Organized December 6, 1919.

Each year The College Club of Canton, Ohio extends to at least one deserving female student a Scholarship Grant in an amount determined by available funding.

The following information will acquaint you with our scholarship grant procedure.

GRANT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Eligibility for a Scholarship Grant is dependent on the applicant becoming a full-time student in a four-year program leading to a Baccalaureate Degree, which would make her eligible for membership in The College Club of Canton.
2. Recipient must be a female resident of a Stark County school district.
3. The selection shall take into account the applicants' scholastic accomplishments, potential for success and financial need.
4. After reviewing the applications and discussing the interview results, the committee shall select a scholarship recipient(s) and present the name(s) to the board of The College Club of Canton for approval.

APPLICATION:

1. Fill out the application form completely, including all separate attachments.
2. Enclose an original transcript of grades and a recent photograph.
3. Return completed application and materials to Chairperson of the Scholarship Grant Selection Committee by **March 1, 2025**.
4. Be available for an interview by members of the Scholarship Grant Committee.
5. To receive the funds, the selected scholarship recipient(s) must present a copy of their fall schedule from their selected institution to the scholarship co-chair. Upon approval, the recipient will receive a check made out to the recipient.
6. Application and required documents can be emailed to: CCCsScholarship24@att.net by **March 1, 2025**.

Applications for the Scholarship Grant can be obtained on The College Club of Canton website at collegeclubofcanton.com and will be available **November 15, 2024**. All Stark County High Schools will receive the information document as well as a copy of the Application by 11/15/2024. All applicants will be contacted.
