Captivating speakers, as well as over 700 entertaining and informative programs through the years have sparked curiosity in a variety of areas.

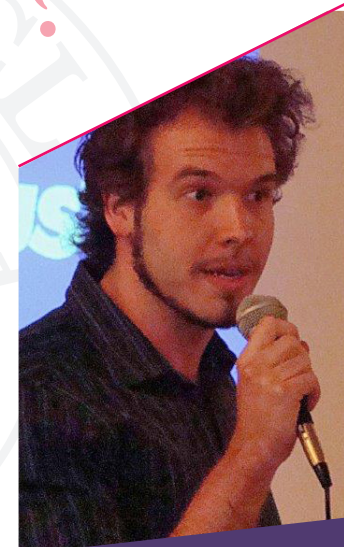
## SECTIONS
